

# **2021 International Training Workshop**

## **- Youth Leadership Camp on Disaster Risk Management**

**25<sup>th</sup> - 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2021**

### **Involving the Role of Science and Technology on Decision Making from Situation Assessment to Field Operation**

Through scenario simulations to hands-on operations, the **National Science and Technology Center for Disaster Reduction (NCDR)** and the **Tzu Chi Foundation (Tzu Chi)**, **Tzu Chi University**, **Tzu Chi University of Science and Technology**, and **International Cooperation and Development Fund (TaiwanICDF)** collaborate to organize the 2021 International Training Workshop - Youth Leadership Camp on Disaster Risk Management (2021 ITW) focusing on capacity building for disaster preparedness in case of typhoon scenario.

Youth can play an important role in disaster preparedness and response because of passion to homeland and sense of social responsibility. The on-site operations of the workshop are designed to empower future leaders with the capacities of situation assessment, decision making, operation and deployment. The challenging missions during the whole event, including smart disaster risk management and strategic process, will be the highlights of the training on applying information intelligence and conducting delivery of humanitarian assistance in case of emergency a scenario typhoon. For a typhoon, besides strong winds and rains, interruptions to lifeline systems, school, business and communications are the possible impacts which need feasible solutions and effective decisions for mitigating adversities. From Day 1 to Day 3, all participants will learn basic knowledge of disaster risk management related to typhoons. On Day 4, a scenario type will invite brainstorming together to meet proposed situations and challenges.

The workshop organizers are looking for meeting undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate international and domestic students majoring in disaster management or relevant disciplines who are enthusiastic fast learners with high mobility and genuine creativity to join the training. The workshop organizers will cover all expenditures, including accommodation, all meals and trains, during the event. The 2021 ITW covers the concept of Cluster Approach from UN OCHA. The expected goals of the 4-day training program are aimed at your capacity building on: 1) **Understanding** of disasters from impacts to operations, 2) **Exploring** the needs of the affected people , 3) **Picturing** the "situation awareness" after a scenario typhoon which could trigger a series of impacts, 4) **Learning** decision making to deliver feasible solutions and allocate resources for coping with challenges, 5) **Streamlining** the data, photo and information collected for situation assessment on cross-cutting issues for integrated communications, 6) **Mobilizing** the tangible and intangible resources for emergency preparedness, 7) **Integrating** team efforts on the scenario simulation for operations, and 8) **Delivering** effective and efficient operation.

**The 4-day expenditure to attend the workshop will be covered by 2021 ITW workshop organizers. The covered items include 4-day meals, training materials, cultural exposure, technical visits, insurance, accommodation and the long-haul ground public transportation in Taiwan (i.e. High Speed Rail, Taiwan Railway, or bus).**

1. The long-haul ground public transportation in Taiwan (i.e. High Speed Rail, Taiwan Railway, Airways or bus) is to be covered based on:
  - 1) from your university/college to Taipei or New Taipei City (the location of opening ceremony) ;
  - 2) from Hualien City (the location of farewell) back to your university/college. It is required to take direct train or bus to the destinations mentioned above.
2. The reimbursement of transportation in Taiwan does not include the short distance commute to and from Taipei and New Taipei City.(i.e. Taipei Metro and New Taipei Metro transportation will not be cover in this case) Taxi is also reimbursed-excluded
3. For the **reimbursement** of the long-haul ground public transportation in Taiwan: **You are required to** provide your:
  - 1) original tickets (High Speed Rail, train, or bus)
  - 2) a copy of passport (international students only)
  - 3) a copy of your bank account cover page (bank in Taiwan) with your name and bank account.

We will reimburse the transportation fee to your bank account in New Taiwan Dollar (NTD) upon receipt of the above -mentioned materials.

*\*\*\* Only international students need to provide your copy of passport; domestic (Taiwanese) students are not required.*

### **The IMPORTANT information:**

1. Participants must agree to attend full 4-day training program as a package with designated vegetarian meals and accommodation (female/ male dorm) by organizers, if registered. Please feel free to contact us if any query or difficulties before registration.
2. Meal and Snack: Vegetarian Diet (**All meals and refreshments will be vegetarian**)
3. Dress Code: Smart Casual for Day 1, Day 2 and 4. For field and hands-on operations on Day 3 (i.e. it is recommend to wear “not easy to get dirty tops and pants”, and comfortable shoes).
4. In case of force majeure (i.e. typhoon), the workshop organizers remain rights to cancel, suspend or postpone the workshop. Workshop participants will be well notified by email, workshop website announcement or telephone if applicable.
5. The workshop certificate will be granted to the active participants if completed the 4-day training program.

### **Suggested items to bring:**

1. cell phone, pad, laptop for hands-on exercise
2. chopsticks/ or knife and fork, lunch box, cup (with name tag) for dining
